GCSO LAW ENFORCEMENT SUMMARY

DECEMBER 1, 2014 – DECEMBER 7, 2014

On Monday, December 1st, the Gulf County Sheriff's Office (GCSO) received a complaint regarding the theft of several sinks and aluminum material from the 400 block of Cox Landing Road in Wewahitchka. Deputy D. Sanders responded to the call and investigated. The total value of the materials stolen was estimated at approximately \$750. The case is still under investigation.

On December 1st, Deputy S. Ferrell took John D. King, Jr. (32) into custody on a Writ of Bodily Attachment for Child Support. King was arrested in the 100 block of Foxchase Drive in Howard Creek. He was transported to the Gulf County Detention Facility (GCDF) where he was later released after posting a \$2,500 purge.

On December 1st, Deputy P. Williams arrested Henry L. Powell, Jr. (52) on a traffic stop located near the Gulf/Bay County Line. Powell was wanted by the Bay County Sheriff's Office for Uttering a Forged Instrument. He was transported and booked into the GCDF.

On Wednesday, December 3rd, the GCSO received a report of credit card fraud. Sgt. J. Williams responded to the 300 block of Beacon Road in St. Joe Beach and contacted the complainant. It was reported that approximately \$28,000 in charges were placed on several different credit cards owned by the complainant. The transactions occurred earlier this year. Investigator L. Dickey continues to investigate the case.

On December 3rd, Lt. T. Wood was contacted in the 300 block of Jeffery Drive in reference to the theft of a bicycle. The complainant reported she left the bike in the 100 block of Venus Drive in Pine Ridge Apartments. The bike was left at the location on November 26th and was discovered missing a week later. It was described as a black and orange colored BMX style bike valued at approximately \$200.

On December 3rd, Deputy G. Desrosier arrested Christopher A. Williams (18) for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia in the 200 block of East Creekview Drive in Stonemill Creek. The arrest was made during the investigation into a 911 call involving an

unknown disturbance. Williams was transported to the GCDF where he was later first appeared and conditionally released.

On December 3rd, Clyde R. McDaniel (51) was arrested and booked into the GCDF on a Writ of Bodily Attachment for Child Support. McDaniel was later released after he posted a \$1,000 purge.

On Thursday, December 4th, Deputy J. Oquendo and Sgt. J. Murnan responded to the 200 block of Ward Street in St. Joe Beach. The GCSO received a call regarding an unknown disturbance. Once the parties were contacted it was determined that one of the subjects provided false information to Deputy Oquendo. David J. Dicho (50) provided a false name and social security number when asked to identify himself. He was placed under arrest for False Information to a Law Enforcement Officer. Dicho also had two warrants in Gulf County for Failure to Appear on original charges of Domestic Battery and Driving While License Suspended/Revoked (DWLS/R). Dicho was also wanted by the Bay County Sheriff's Office. He was transported to the GCDF where he remains in custody.

On December 4th, the GCSO extradited Jessica P. Hernandez (22) from the Bay County Jail to Gulf County on a warrant for Failure to Appear. Hernandez original charge was Criminal Mischief. She was booked into the GCDF and released on her own recognizance.

On December 4th, Deputy G. Desrosier arrested Michael B. McDaniel (34) in the 100 block of State Road (SR) 22 in Wewahitchka. McDaniel was wanted for Violation of Probation (VOP) on his original charge of Felony DWLS/R. He was transported to the GCDF where he was later released after posting a \$5,000 bond.

On Friday, December 5th, Deputy S. Ferrell arrested Scotty L. Herrell (42) in the 400 block of Honey Hill Road near Burgess Creek. Herrell was taken into custody on a Writ of Bodily Attachment for Child Support. He was transported to the GCDF where he remains in custody on a \$1,200 purge, or serve 180 days in jail.

On Saturday, December 6th, Deputy S. Ferrell arrested Jeremy J. Nunnery (38) in the 200 block of Bay Avenue in Wewahitchka. Nunnery was taken into custody on a Writ of Bodily Attachment for Child Support. He was transported to the GCDF where he remains in custody on a \$9,000 purge, or serve 180 days in jail.

On December 6th, Deputy B. Smith took a report involving the theft of a cooler. The complainant reported that someone stole his Yeti cooler out of the back of his pick-up truck. The incident is believed to have occurred while the vehicle was parked in the 100 block of County Road (CR) 381. The cooler was described as a gray 65 gallon Yeti brand ice chest valued at approximately \$340.

On Sunday, December 7th, Deputy D. Sanders was on patrol and observed a vehicle exceeding the posted speed limit. The vehicle was traveling 61 mph in a posted 35 mph

zone. Deputy Sanders stopped the vehicle on SR 71 south of Wewahitchka and made contact with the driver, Estevan Rivera (23). Rivera was not licensed to operate a motor vehicle and was taken into custody. He was transported to the GCDF where he was charged with Operating a Vehicle without a License. Rivera was first appeared and conditionally released.
