Gulf County Sheriff's Office (GCSO) Investigators and Deputies executed the warrants on the morning of Thursday, December 11, 2014. Each case was the result of investigations conducted by the GCSO Narcotics Unit.

At the time investigators arrested Stripling, Green, and Gates on warrants for the Sale of Meth they were found in possession of meth and drug paraphernalia. At the time of Monks arrest she was found in possession of drug paraphernalia. Each defendant was transported to the Gulf County Detention Facility where they were later first appeared.

"We continue to seek out those who sale drugs in Gulf County," said Sheriff Mike Harrison, "and I encourage citizens to report suspected drug activity by calling the Sheriff's Office at 850-227-1115, or Crime Stoppers at 850-785-TIPS."
