GCSO LAW ENFORCEMENT SUMMARY

April 11, 2016 – April 17, 2016

On Monday, April 11, Investigator P. Williams and Investigator S. Ferrell arrested Steven Michael Arthur (22) in the 200 block of Duval Street in Oak Grove. Arthur was wanted for Contempt of Court resulting from an original charge of Possession of Less Than Twenty Grams of Marijuana. He was transported to the Gulf County Detention Facility (GCDF).

On April 11, the Gulf County Sheriff's Office (GCSO) received a complaint of a counterfeit \$10.00 bill being passed at TL James Ball Park. Deputy G. Desrosier responded to investigate and took possession of the counterfeit currency.

On April 11, the GCSO received a burglary complaint that occurred in the 7000 block of Highway 98 in St. Joe Beach. Deputy S. Cook responded and conducted an investigation. During the burglary, two Necky brand kayaks along with two paddles were stolen. One kayak is purple in color and the other is yellow in color. This investigation is ongoing.

On Tuesday, April 12, 2016, Megan Leigh Lincoln (25) was arrested at the Gulf County Courthouse for an active Bay County warrant for Trafficking Amphetamines, Possession of More Than Twenty Grams of Marijuana, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. She was taken into custody and delivered to the GCDF.

On April 12, the GCSO received a complaint in the 400 block of State Road 71 in Wewahitchka that a person over 65 years of age had been battered by their daughter. Deputy G. Desrosier responded and conducted an investigation. The investigation revealed the victim, a person over 65 years of age, had been battered and as a result sustained injuries. Deputy G. Desrosier arrested Cindy Ann Gaskin (56). Gaskin was charged Battery on a Person 65 years of age or older and transported to the GCDF.

On April 12, Deputy C. Sanders conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle in the area of State Road 71 and the Dynamite Dock Road. The vehicle was driven by Jeffery Ryan Marshall (31). Deputy C. Sanders arrested Marshall for Knowing Driving on a Suspended Driver

License, Giving False Identification to a Law Enforcement Officer, and Resisting an Officer without Violence. He was transported to the GCDF.

On Wednesday, April 13, 2016, the GCSO received a criminal mischief complaint in the 2000 block of Highway 22A in Wewahitchka. Deputy M. Peek responded to conduct an investigation. The investigation revealed Lillie Mae Davis (42) used a knife to deliberately cut the radiator hose to the victim's vehicle. Davis was subsequently arrested after an arrest warrant for Criminal Mischief was obtained on April 15. She was transported to the GCDF.

On Thursday, April 14, 2016, the GCSO received a complaint that a burglary had occurred at the concession stand at T.L. James Ball Park in Wewahitchka. Deputy C. Harvey and Investigator L. Dickey responded to investigate. It was determined the cash register, food items, and other miscellaneous items had been stolen. Investigator L. Dickey continues to investigate.

On April 14, Michael Douglas Fordham (29) was arrested at the Gulf County Courthouse for Failure to Appear. He was taken to the GCDF.

On April 14, the GCSO received a complaint of a burglary that occurred at the concession stand at the horse arena located on Old Dairy Farm Road in Wewahitchka. Deputy C. Harvey and Investigator L. Dickey responded to conduct an investigation. It was determined food items and miscellaneous household items had been stolen from the concession stand. Investigator L. Dickey continues to investigate.

On Saturday, April 16, 2016, the GCSO received a complaint of a possible physical disturbance between a man and woman taking place on the beach in the area of the Bay/Gulf County line. Deputy C. Sanders responded to the scene and located the man and woman. The investigation revealed the man and woman were just having a verbal argument. Deputy C. Sander checked both subjects for warrants and it was confirmed the male subject who had been identified as Todd Martin Cleaver (39) did have an active warrant for Violation of Probation from a previous Burglary charge out of Lee County, Florida. Cleaver was arrested and transported to the GCDF.
